

Tad Spurgeon:

How To Buy a Painting

Step 1: The most recent work is always on the News page of my website. If you see something you like, you can copy and paste the image into an email, or simply describe it to me. I'll then send you a larger version of the image, and a price. Prices include packing and shipping.

However, sometimes the paintings on the News are still in progress, and may take a while to complete.

Alternatively, you can ask to see finished images. Just let me know a little about what you'd like: landscape, still life, Vermont landscape, Italy, etc. I'll then send you a group of images from which to select, with sizes and prices. You tell me which images from this group interest you, and I then send you higher resolution images of these. These images can be quite detailed, I'm happy to do this to make sure you have as much information as you'd like to make a decision.

Step 2: If you find something you would like to own, you let me know which painting and send the asking price to my account at PayPal. I then ship you the painting. There may be a few days delay if the painting needs to be mounted or varnished. After the painting arrives, you have **two** days to decide whether you want to keep it, or ship it back to me in the original packing. If you ship it back, I will refund your money via PayPal once it has arrived. PayPal is very safe for both parties, but if you would rather pay by check, let me know.

Please email me if you have any questions about this process. I am very happy to work with you to make sure you get something you can enjoy for decades to come, and am happy to say that, since 2003, no paintings have ever been returned.
